

# STANDING RULES FOR USE OF BROOKWOOD POOL

- ❖ **NO RUNNING** on cement apron around pool.
- ❖ **NO DIVING** off the board until the water beneath the board is clear of all swimmers. Only diving **straight** off the board is permitted. Vests with a strap that attaches between the legs are permitted. Arm floaties that are good & snug are allowed. There will NOT be any jumping from diving board onto floatation devices. NO goggles while jumping or diving from board.
- ❖ **GROUP GAMES** (i.e. Alligator) are permitted for 15 minutes only every two hours with permission of the lifeguard on duty. The lifeguard can make an exception to this policy provided the game will not interfere with other members wishing to swim. **NO WATER GUNS PERMITTED**
- ❖ Any game played in the water will require permission of the lifeguard on duty.
- ❖ During peak hours, large floats are not permitted.
- ❖ Anyone bringing or eating food inside the pool area **MUST** dispose of all trash properly into a trash container. **NO GLASS** containers are permitted.
- ❖ No chewing gum is permitted inside the pool area.
- ❖ The baby pool is reserved for children **6** years of age and younger **ONLY**. No diapers may be worn in the pool. Any child not potty trained **MUST** wear swimming diapers (i.e. Huggies Little Swimmers)
- ❖ Radios may be played at a reasonable volume that will not disturb anyone else in the pool or on neighboring properties. The lifeguard will have discretion in determining “reasonable volume”.
- ❖ No type of ball playing will be allowed inside of fenced area.
- ❖ Anyone in the pool area must obey the lifeguard on duty at all times.
- ❖ **Local guests** must pay guest fee and must sign in with an adult member.
- ❖ A caregiver that is at least **16 years old** must accompany **children under 13**. ***You must 13 years old to be alone/without a parent at the pool.***

The lifeguard may ask anyone violating any of these rules to sit out or leave the pool area. All members **MUST** respect the authority of the lifeguards. They are here for the safety of all members.
